## Special Terms and Conditions of Hire Maitland Gaol “Sleepovers”

1. These conditions are in addition to the “General Terms and Conditions of Hire for Maitland Gaol or Part Thereof” and especially relate to bookings where the patrons are to stay within the Gaol precinct for the entire night. These conditions do not exclude the General Terms and Conditions which must also be adhered to for “sleepovers”.
2. A minimum group size payment of 25 persons applies to “sleepover” bookings. Where the group minimum of 25 persons is not reached, an additional charge at the applicable rate will be made for the difference between the actual number of attendees and 25.
3. The fee for “sleepovers” includes welcome by your “Guard”, torchlight tour, sleepover venue. The “Guard” will “lockdown” patrons at around 11.00pm and remain on-site overnight. The “Guard” is not responsible for the supervision of patrons. This is the responsibility of the hirer (see General Terms and Conditions)
4. Adults are deemed to be persons over the age of 18 years. Persons below the age of 6 years are not permitted on “sleepover” bookings.
5. Persons under the age of 18 MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult who is either a parent, guardian or authorised group coordinator from a recognised organisation. A minimum ratio of 1 to 10 responsible adults to children is required for supervision purposes.
6. The hirer must attend the function and is responsible for all activity by patrons on the night.
7. Minors must not consume alcohol in the facility. Providing alcohol to minors is an offence and the authorised staff will require offenders and the minors to leave the facility.
8. Glass must not be brought into the facility.
9. Toilet facilities are available all night but shower facilities are not available.
10. Patrons for “sleepovers” should bring with them Prison Pyjamas, mattress/airbed, sleeping bag/blankets, torch, camera, food, drink and toiletries.
